AMBERWOOD ALSO NEEDED TO EVOKE IMAGERY OF BEING IN A DENSE WOOD SO I DEvised A SET OF "RULES" THAT THEN BECAME THE BASE CONCEPT FOR THE TYPEFACE DRAWINGS.

THE BREWERY WAS EVENTUALLY RENAMED SUNDOWN BREWING BEFORE LAUNCHING SO THE AMBERWOOD WORDMARK NEVER SAW THE LIGHT OF DAY. THE IDEA WAS TO CREATE A ROUGH DRAFT OF A FONT AND GATHER BACKERS WHO WOULD FUND THE PROJECT (LIKE KICKSTARTER) AND IF SUCCESSFUL THE FONT WOULD HAVE BEEN

I CHOSE AMBERWOOD, BUILT OUT THE REMAINING LETTERS IN A QUICK DRAFT. IT WAS FAR ENOUGH ALONG TO MAKE SOME QUICK GRAPHICS TO GARNER INTEREST BUT STILL HAD A LONG WAY TO GO BEFORE BECOMING A COHESIVE FONT.
