

Comma™ Base • A missing link between serif & sans

Comma™ Base is a *sans* typeface for it has no serifs, quite obviously. No wait, it is a *serif* typeface because the characters have a high contrast, something that is typically seen in serif typefaces only. So it has half the features of a sans, and half the features of a serif. The question is: how would one call it, a *semi-sans* or a *semi-serif*?

Upon asking this question to my fellow type designers, there were several suggestions for this old classification problem: *stressed sans*, *trans-serif*, *contrasted sans*, *semi-serif*, *semi-sans*, *serifless roman*, *high-contrasted sans*, *glyphic serif*, *incise*, *sanif*, *vestigial serif*. It is clear that it is not easy to come up with a good suffix, however one suggestion stuck, a simple but effective name: *base*.

This typeface could function as a *base* from which a sans can be derived, but it could also be the base for a real serif typeface. And in itself it has enough qualities to survive as a stand-alone typeface.

Comma™ Base can be seen as a missing link between serif and sans, a fork in the road from which one can turn left or right. In fact it combines the best of both worlds...



Comma consists of 16 styles, 8 weights from Hairline to **Ultra**, in both roman and *italic*. It contains a complete character set, including a full set of accented characters that provide comprehensive linguistic support for 37 languages.

Comma supports several OpenType® layout features, such as small caps, *all* small caps, case sensitive forms, eight sets of figures, automatic fractions, ligatures and discretionary ligatures. These features give the user advanced typographic control.

Comma's character widths are consistent along its weight axis, so whatever the weight is – normal, light or black – they all take up the same amount of space. This means changing a text from normal to bold doesn't effect the set width. This feature is called **uniwidth**, a professional feature that is highly appreciated by graphic designers.

Comma to a large extent is based on the lettering I did for a 2017 post stamp design for the Dutch postal service. For obvious reasons the



text on the stamp had to be small. To achieve maximum legibility within the limited space I ended up making a sans with an extremely high 'seriflike' contrast, with scaled down capitals and with relatively short ascenders. After the stamp had been printed and released I looked again at the letters and I then saw its potential to develop it into an actual typeface. First of all I was thinking of a headline face, but I then realized – when equipped with kerning, OpenType features and several weights – it would be quite suitable as a text face too.

Comma wouldn't be **Comma** if it didn't have a very small special character: a comma! And with this I mean the first comma around, a *Roman comma*, as found on many old Roman inscriptions. It is shown below, between my name and the date I finished this typeface.


