The country dance was introduced to the court of Louis XIV of France, where it became known as contredanse, and later to Germany and Italy. André Lorin, who visited the English court in the late 17th century, presented a large manuscript of dances in the English manner to Louis XIV on his return to France. In 1706 Raoul Auger Feuillet published his book, *Recüeil de Contredances*, a collection of “contredances anglaises” presented in a simplified form of Beauchamp, Feuillet notation and including some dances invented by the author as well as authentic English dances. This was subsequently translated into English by John Essex and soon published in England as *For the Further Improvement of Dancing*.
